3	4.3	E, T	It is unclear in this paragraph what is meant by "statements regarding accuracy/success of facial approximation methods should be carefully presented". Are you referring to "accuracy/success" statements made after an unidentified person is scientifically identified (at which time an assessment of the "likeness" of the image may be done), or "accuracy/success" statements made in published articles/books about specific facial approximation methods, or something else?	Please clarify what is intended here, perhaps by adding examples of when and where "accuracy/success" statements have been used (erroneously or correctly)	Accept
