Some members of the OSAC LTG (speaking as individuals, not in an OSAC capacity) have concerns that the standard undermines a linear approach to ACE-V, and that the documentation and report requirements are insufficient. If there is an additional chance to offer substantive comments on these portions we would send them immediately and be grateful. Thank you and apologies if this didn't happen before (we can't find a record of whether we have commented on a previous version).	Reject: Opening this full document for another round of comment (as there have been 5 opportunities) would complicate the accredited standards process that the ASB has followed. As with all documents, this document will be up for revision in a few years, and the CB feels that, as a first edition, this document is a good place for the industry to start and in future revisions, the requirements can be modified as appropriate for the discipline.
