(We process evidence, but shouldn't process victims) I would advocate for utilizing more germane terminology. In almost all uses of "processing" directed toward victim remains, "medicolegal investigation" can be substituted, and encompass the entirety of the "process"	Reject with modification. The CB feels that the term "processing" encompasses the entire DVI process necessary for the identification of decedents, including cause and manner of death. Additionally, this definition was revised to be in alignment with other ASB MFM-DVI documents.
